Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

1. Read **Luke 9:22**. As we have seen throughout our study of Luke, Jesus prefers the designation "The Son of Man." When we give that some thought (especially, as in this context, in reference to his crucifixion) how can this bring us a greater sense of the cost of our redemption?
2. Read **Daniel 7:13-14, Matthew 26:64-65, Acts 7:56, and Revelation 1:13-16**. How do these references to the Son of Man lead us to conclude that Jesus is far more than a great earthly king?
3. Read **Hebrews 1:1-4, Philippians 2:5-8, and 1 John 4:1-3**. Why is it problematic for people and religious groups to deny Christ's deity?
4. Read **John 5:21-23, 8:56-59, and Luke 5:20-24**. How do words and actions like these demonstrate Christ's divinity?
5. Read **Hebrews 4:14-16**. How does this description of the God-Man give you hope and encouragement?
