3. Read **1 Corinthians 15:42-49**. What are some of the specific things that boost your anticipation about your future resurrection when reading this passage?
4. Read **Revelation 22:1-7** and **Psalms 16:11**. How does walking obediently on that "path of life" increase your anticipation of the eternal state, and why do you think disobedience hampers it?
